NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

The City of Gary Department of Commerce, Community Development Division, would like to amend and make public the following changes to its Consolidated Annual Action Plans for Program Year 2015 and Program Year 2017.

- Budgeted 2015 Program Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$61,366.50 for Curbs and Sidewalks will be increased to \$99,471.00.
- Description and activities for 2017 Program Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project #27 - Infrastructure Improvements (Curbs and Sidewalks) will be amended as follows:

<u>Project #27 – Infrastructure Improvements-Curbs and Sidewalks - \$208,862</u>

Activity #1 – Owner-Occupied Rehab Program Curbs and Sidewalks - \$126,966.50 CDBG funds will be used for the installation of curbs, sidewalks, and/or tree removal and replanting only in the University Park and/or Emerson target areas as part of a beautification project where the Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program activity will be conducted. Approximately 6,585 persons will be assisted.

Activity #2 – Reed Park Curbs and Sidewalks - \$81,895.50

CDBG funds will be used for the installation of curbs and sidewalks at Reed Park located at 15th Avenue and Connecticut Street. Approximately 500 persons will be assisted.

The changes are consistent with the Citizen Participation Plan for the City of Gary, Department of Commerce, Community Development Division. The changes are considered substantial changes according to the criteria of the Plan. The amendment is consistent with Title 24, Department of Housing and Urban Development Regulations Part 91, Subpart F, Section 91.505 and Subpart B, Section 91.105.
