



PARKING REQUIREMENTS

USE	REQUIRED PARKING SPACES
RESIDENTIAL USES	
Single-family dwelling	One space per dwelling unit
Two-family dwelling	One space per dwelling unit
Multiple-family dwelling	0.75 spaces per dwelling unit; 0.5 spaces per efficiency unit
Tourist Court, tourist home, and motel	One space per room
Hotel	One space per dwelling unit; one space per three lodging rooms
Lodging house	One space per three rooms and one space for the owner/manager
Private club/lodge (with sleeping facilities)	One space per three lodging rooms; additional parking at ten percent capacity for club space (exclusive of lodging room capacity)
RETAIL AND SERVICE USES	
Retail store and bank	One space per 300 sq. ft. of floor area in excess of 2,000 sq. ft., except in B5-2 one space per 300 feet of floor area in excess of 5,000 sq. ft.
Automobile service station	One space per three employees
Bowling alley	Three spaces per each alley, plus additional spaces for affiliated uses (bars, etc.)
Establishment dispensing food or beverages for consumption on premises	One space per 400 sq. ft. in excess of 4,000 sq. ft., except B5-2 one space per 400 sq. ft. in excess of 7,500 sq. ft.
Furniture and appliance store, household repair	One space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 4,000 sq. ft., except B5-2 one space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 7,500 sq. ft.
Motor vehicle sales and machinery sales	One space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 4,000 sq. ft., except B5-2 one space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 7,500 sq. ft.
Theater (indoor)	One space per ten seats up to 500 seats, plus one space per five seats above 500
Undertaker, funeral parlor	Five spaces per chapel or parlor, plus one space per funeral vehicle kept on premises
Office: business, professional, governmental	One space per 500 sq. ft. in excess of 4,000 sq. ft., except B5-2 one space per 500 sq. ft. in excess of 7,500 sq. ft.
Wholesale establishment (excluding storage, warehouses)	One space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 4,000 sq. ft., except B52, one space per 600 sq. ft. in excess of 7,500 sq. ft.
Establishment engaged in production, processing, cleaning, servicing, testing, repair of goods or products	One space per three employees, plus one space per vehicle kept on premises
Warehouse and storage building	One space per three employees, plus one space per vehicle kept on premises
COMMUNITY SERVICE USES	
Church or other religious auditorium	One space per four seats
School, college, other institutional auditorium	One space per 12 seats
Health center, government operated	Three spaces per staff member or visiting doctor
Hospital	One space per three beds, one space per doctor, one

Library, art gallery, museum	One space per 1,000 sq. ft. of gross floor area
Recreation or community center	One space per three employees, plus additional spaces as determined by BZA to serve visiting public
Public utility and public service uses	One space per three employees, plus additional spaces as determined by BZA to serve visiting public
School (nursery, elementary, high school)	One space per three employees
Stadium, arena, convention hall, dancehall, skating rink, similar places of assembly	Parking spaces equal in number to ten percent capacity
MISCELLANEOUS USES	
Fraternity or sorority house	One space per five active members, one space for manager
Institution for the care of mental illness	One space per staff doctor, plus additional spaces as determined by BZA to serve visiting public
Private club and lodge (without sleeping facilities)	Parking spaces equal in number to ten percent capacity
Nursing home, sanitarium, convalescent home, institution for the aged or children	One space per six beds, one space per doctor, one space per three employees
Drive-in theatre	Reservoir parking space equal to ten percent vehicle capacity
Airport, aircraft landing field, heliport	Parking determined by BZA
Convent, monastery, rectory, parish house	Parking determined by BZA
Fraternal or religious institution	Parking determined by BZA
Outdoor amusement establishment ; fairgrounds, etc.	Parking determined by BZA
Swimming pool	Parking determined by BZA
Mixed uses: when two or more uses are located on the same lot or same building	Sum of separate requirements for each use
All other uses	Parking determined by BZA

Handicapped Parking Requirements

- Any parking facility under the jurisdiction or control of a public agency must reserve a handicapped parking space.
 - At least two handicapped parking spaces must be reserved if a facility contains 25 or fewer spaces; at least four spaces must be reserved for a facility has 26-50 spaces; six spaces must be reserved if the facility has more than 50 spaces
 - If a public facility has no parking facilities, it must request an adjacent portion of the street for handicapped parking.
 - All handicapped parking must be clearly marked and visible from the spaces assigned.
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
